DBT - Subject Review Process

The Subject Review of the Department of the Biotechnology was carried out by the Quality Assurance and Accreditation (QAA) Council of the University Grants Commission on 14th and 16th September 2009. The review team consisted of Prof (Mrs.) Kshanika Hirimburegama (University of Colombo), Prof. Sanath Hettiarachchi (University of Ruhuna), Prof. (Mrs) SE Peiris (University of Peradeniya), Dr. AAY Amarasinghe (Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka).

Eight aspects were evaluated during the review process and seven aspects were judged good. In their recommendations, special emphasis was given to reduce the total credit requirement and curriculum revision.
